For the last 30 years he was acting as a consultant in consumer protection, product safety and market surveillance, by several international institutions and governments in Europe, Canada, South America, the Caribbean countries, and North and Central Africa. Since 2013 he was the team leader of several government-run projects on consumer protection and product safety in the GCC countries and in particular in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. In 2016, he was appointed as an independent expert in the *Committee of governmental experts on consumer law and policy of the United Nations (UNCTAD)*.
